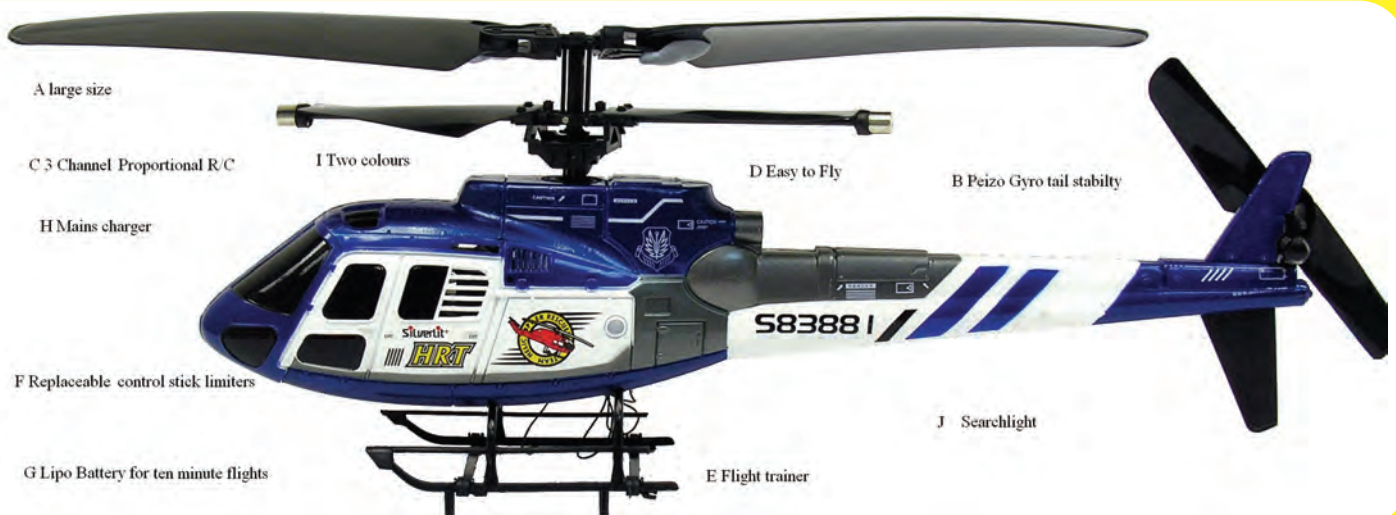

SE85879 Picoo Z XL Vortex 3-Channel R/C Helicopter

Significantly [A] larger than the original infrared micro picoo Z, Silverlit's brand new Picoo Z XL Vortex is literally twice the overall length, but looks much bigger!

Incorporating a [B] sophisticated Piezo gyro system to maintain its heading, Flying Toys' new top-of-the-range flagship Picoo Z incorporates [C] three-channel proportional radio-control, making this [D] easy and fun to fly outdoors in calm conditions.

With more than ten million tiny Picoo Z helicopters already in circulation worldwide, the Picoo Z XL Vortex provides a useful step up to more traditional R/C helicopters, for the indoor micro-chopper enthusiast looking to progress further.

An informative instruction manual and DVD have been supplied to show the prospective new helicopter pilot exactly how it's done. Furthermore, Silverlit have thoughtfully included an [E] innovative flight trainer that attaches to the undercarriage, to make smooth takeoffs and landings much easier and safer for beginners!

The transmitter incorporates [F] replaceable control stick caps to restrict their movement whilst learning how to manoeuvre the helicopter, and individual flight trims.

Takeoff, hover, turn left and right, fly forwards or backwards precisely with a fixed heading, and land perfectly under full control.

The [G] lightweight Lithium Polymer battery will provide up to ten minutes of flying fun, whilst the helicopter can be ready for takeoff again in less than half an hour using the [H] UK mains charger provided.

An attractive gift box illustrates [I] two distinctive colour schemes, available on 27MHz bands A & B, allowing both styles to be flown together where appropriate.

Featuring a flashing red power indicator and [J] bright blue switchable LED searchlight, the Piezo auto stability system makes this helicopter ideal to operate indoors in a sports hall or reasonably large room, as well as outstanding for flying outside!
